To achieve this outcome we support our young players through the Randwick Rugby Club Scholarship program. This will support you to simultaneously pursue your rugby and academic/career ambitions.

We firmly believe that this will help deliver life changing education and career opportunities to you as you represent the represent the club so proudly in 2018 and beyond.

RANDWICK RUGBY STRATEGY FOR SUCCESS

Promising players must make considerable personal and financial sacrifices to compete at the highest level. Many Clubs address this by paying players.

We do not believe that this is sustainable.

New challenges

- Young men on leaving school and entering life need further qualifications and assistance to prepare them for vocational and sporting success.
- Money alone is not a sustainable answer either for the good of young men, or of rugby clubs.

New Approach

• Developing players need a blend of career and rugby skills, with some financial assistance to prepare them for careers and leadership roles beyond rugby.

Partnership solutions

- Randwick Rugby therefore now offers a Club Scholarship program to provide for young rugby players with suitable potential and qualities. Most of these scholarships are \$1500 per player and scholarship payment is linked to successful academic achievement.
- We are seeking the support of past players, corporate partners and supporters to fund this initiative.

DETAILS OF RANDWICK'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



- \$1500 per annum commitment to fund TAFE, University and other tertiary education and skills.
- Scholarship to be named after the donor who mentors the player on and off the field.



• The Club Scholarship Program is tailored to target and assist boys to continue their education and career skills training





- To support and encourage players to undertake degree, diploma or certificate skills programs including: University, TAFE, trade apprenticeships and other tertiary courses
- Payment is made to the player in two instalments based on successful academic progress.



FLEXIBILITY OF STUDY AT UNSW:

The following are areas where elite athletes and performers may receive support by UNSW:

- Flexibility to tailor academic study load and timetables to integrate with performing or sporting commitments.
- Provision of access to distance education materials, and/or class notes for missed lectures, tutorials or practicals.
- Negotiate assessment deadlines based on related travel commitments.
- Sit exams externally under exam conditions.
- Have the minimum attendance at lectures, tutorials or practicals waived where student is unavailable due to related commitments.
- Leave of absence where required due to increased commitments, e.g., Olympic Games and other representative rugby performances.
